**Old Business:** Discussion was continued on the status of private bridge inspection and posting of loads. Paul Hazucha provided the following information on roads and bridges in general which applies to the three bridges on Bayside South.


1. Subdivision plats as approved by the county and on file with the circuit court dedicate the right of way (ROW) as public access. The ROW is not included in lot owners deeds. Re: Property Appraiser
2. The County will not be responsible for roads and bridge maintenance unless the developer constructs them to County standards and they are accepted. This was not done. Re: County Roads and Bridges.
3. A legal resolution would be required to resolve 1. and 2. above. Re: Property Appraiser
4. Memo from Coggins Insurance (attached) outlines our responsibility and as stated we have complied regarding our actions taken on the Bernath Bridge.

**New Business:** 1. The annual hose testing was completed with no failures noted. 2 Bids were received on the boat for sale. Two bids were submitted. The boat will be sold to TC Thrower with the high bid of \$2000. (Bids attached).


**Correspondence and Communication:** ISO letter dated 13 April 2018 on Community Outreach Program was answered with no changes.
